SUMMER TAXES- Mailed out July 1st and are due without penalty August 31st

WINTER TAXES- Mailed out December 1st and are due without penalty February 14th

*****Payments are due in office or drop box by closing time (see above) on due date- Postmark NOT Accepted*****



WATER/SEWER BILLS: Sent out quarterly- January/April/July/October will always be due on the 21st of those months.

*****Payments and/or payment arrangements (if allowed) are due in office or drop box by closing time (see above) on that due date.**

YARD WASTE: Picked up Tuesday with Trash- April through November

Must be in paper yard waste bags or a properly marked yard waste container. The weight should be 30 lbs or less. Stickers are available at City Hall.

NO PLASTIC BAGS!! Brush up to 2 inches in diameter and 4 foot long and tied securely in bundles not exceeding 18 inches in diameter & stacked neatly will be collected with the yard waste. This service is in addition to the city brush chipping service.



BRUSH CHIPPING: Picked up April through October (everyother week-days vary) The brush must be **neatly stacked** with **ALL** cut ends to the road, no larger then 4 inches in diameter and 4 feet long and at the curb by 8:00am Monday morning the week of chipping. (see reverse)



SNOW/SIDEWALK CLEARING ORDINANCE: Whenever any snow or ice has fallen or accumulated on the sidewalk, it shall be cleared within 48 hours of the time it fell or accumulated. See section 15-21 of the municode.



WEED/GRASS GROWTH ORDINANCE: No person owning any premises shall permit or maintain on any such premises any growth of noxious *weeds*; nor any growth of grass or other rank vegetation to a greater height than six inches on average. See section 20-21 of the municode.



PAVILION RESERVATIONS: Pavilion Rental charges are for Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays May through October

Reservations are for Elms Park and Abrams Park- **ALL monies, including \$200 refundable deposit must be paid at time of reservation.**

Reservations are accepted starting January 1st for city residents and April 1st for everyone.
